Viola Sallay being bilingual, the seminar will be conducted in French/English; a French-English translation will be provided if necessary

The purpose of the essentially clinical seminar is the presentation, introduction and experimentation of a systemic therapeutic tool developed by Viola Sallay and her colleagues of the University of Szeged in Hungary: The interview of the emotional map of the home. This interview is conducted on the basis of a drawing of their home by the family members ; the tool was originally used for research on mental health and self-regulation in people with chronic illness and their families before finding its application in systemic family therapy. It is a very interesting to be used both in the first meetings with families to identify the request and in the course of consultations and care. After a morning session devoted to the presentation of the tool and clinical vignettes, the afternoon will be dedicated to small group experimentation and clinical exchange with and between the participants.

focused on the
emotional self-regulating
processes of people
with chronic illness and
their entourage in the

family home. With her

the 'safe home
interview' research
protocol to systemic
family therapy. She
represents national
Hungarian family
therapists at EFTA.
